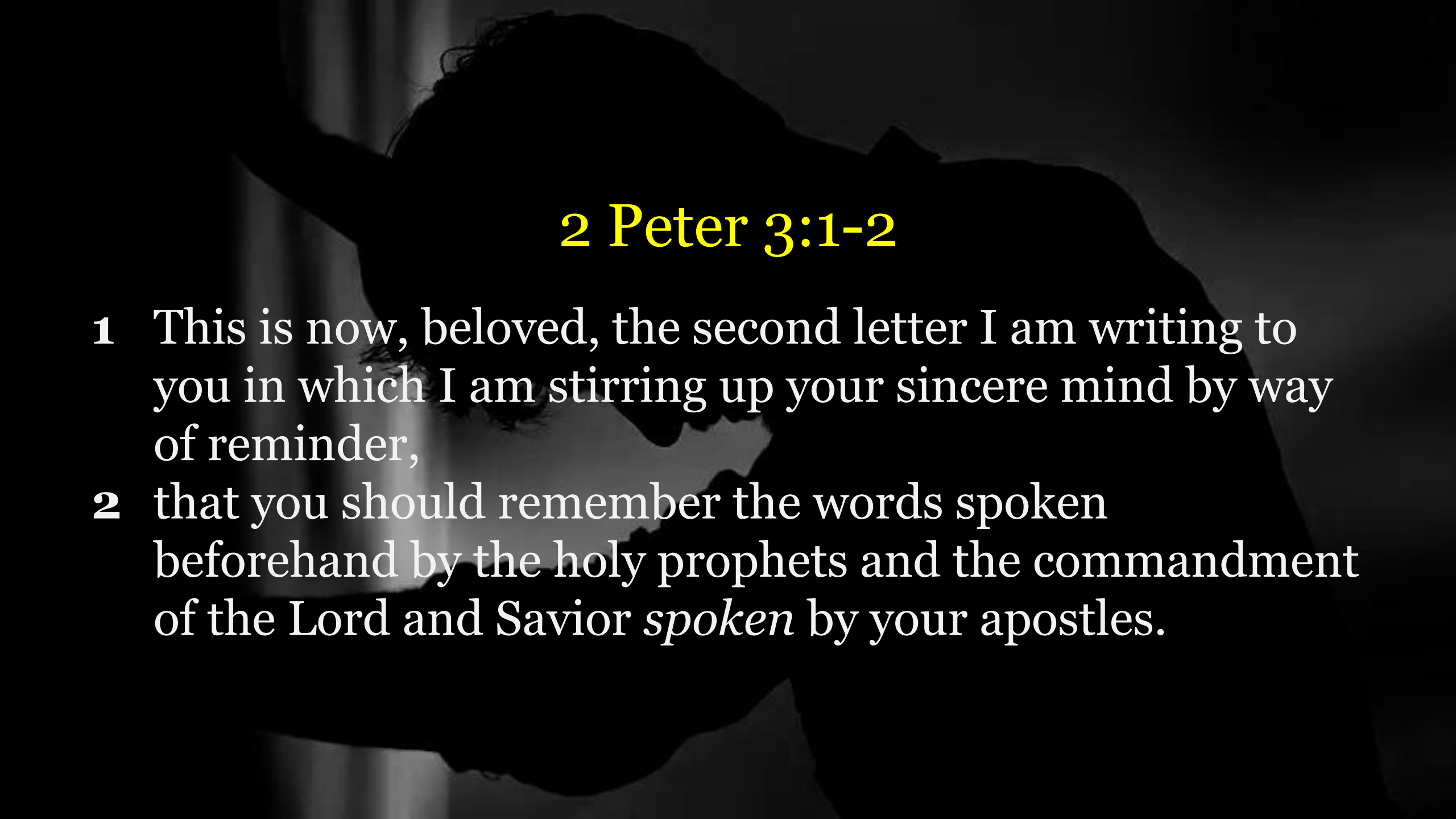

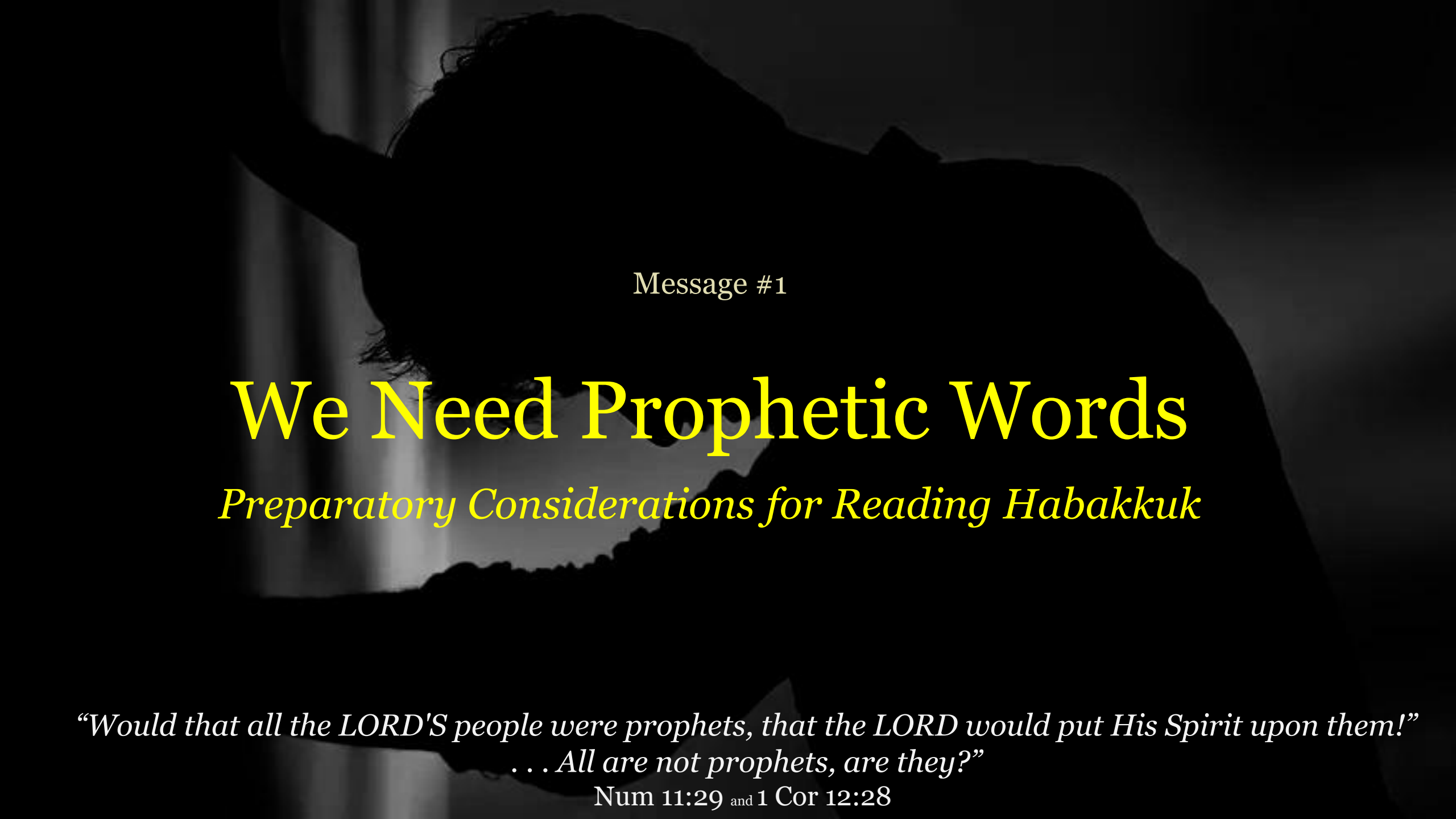

... All are not prophets, are they?”*

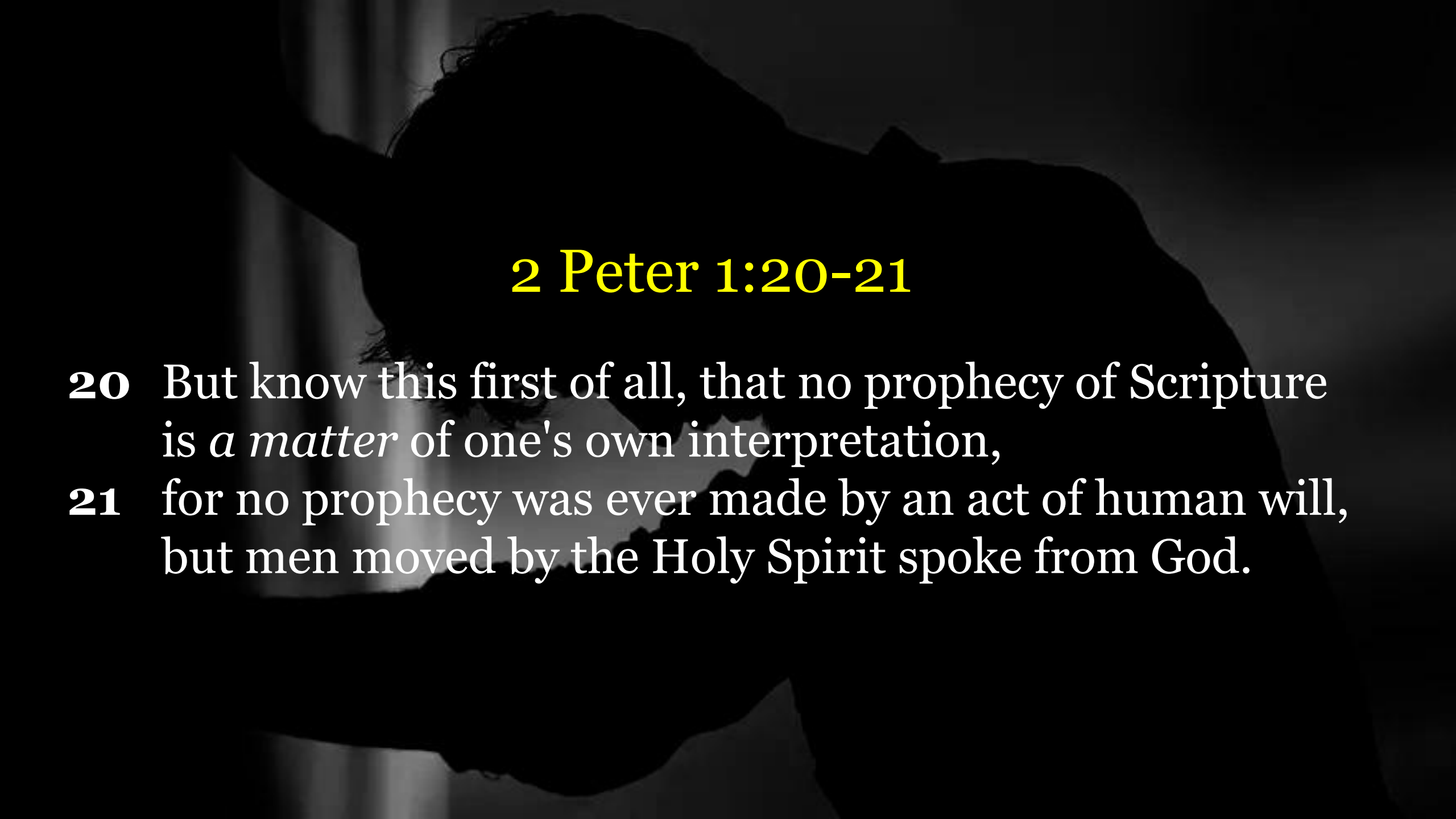
