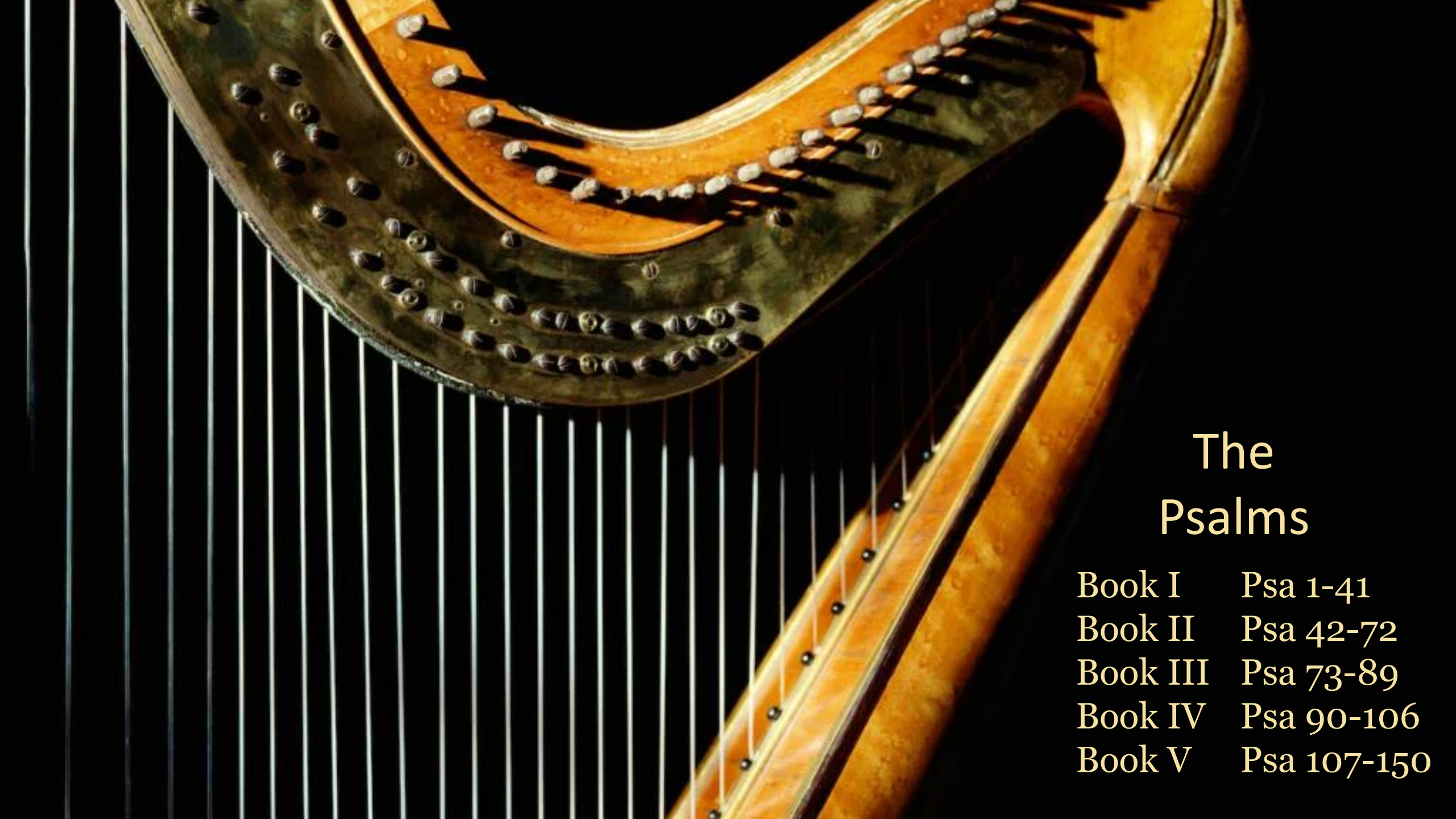

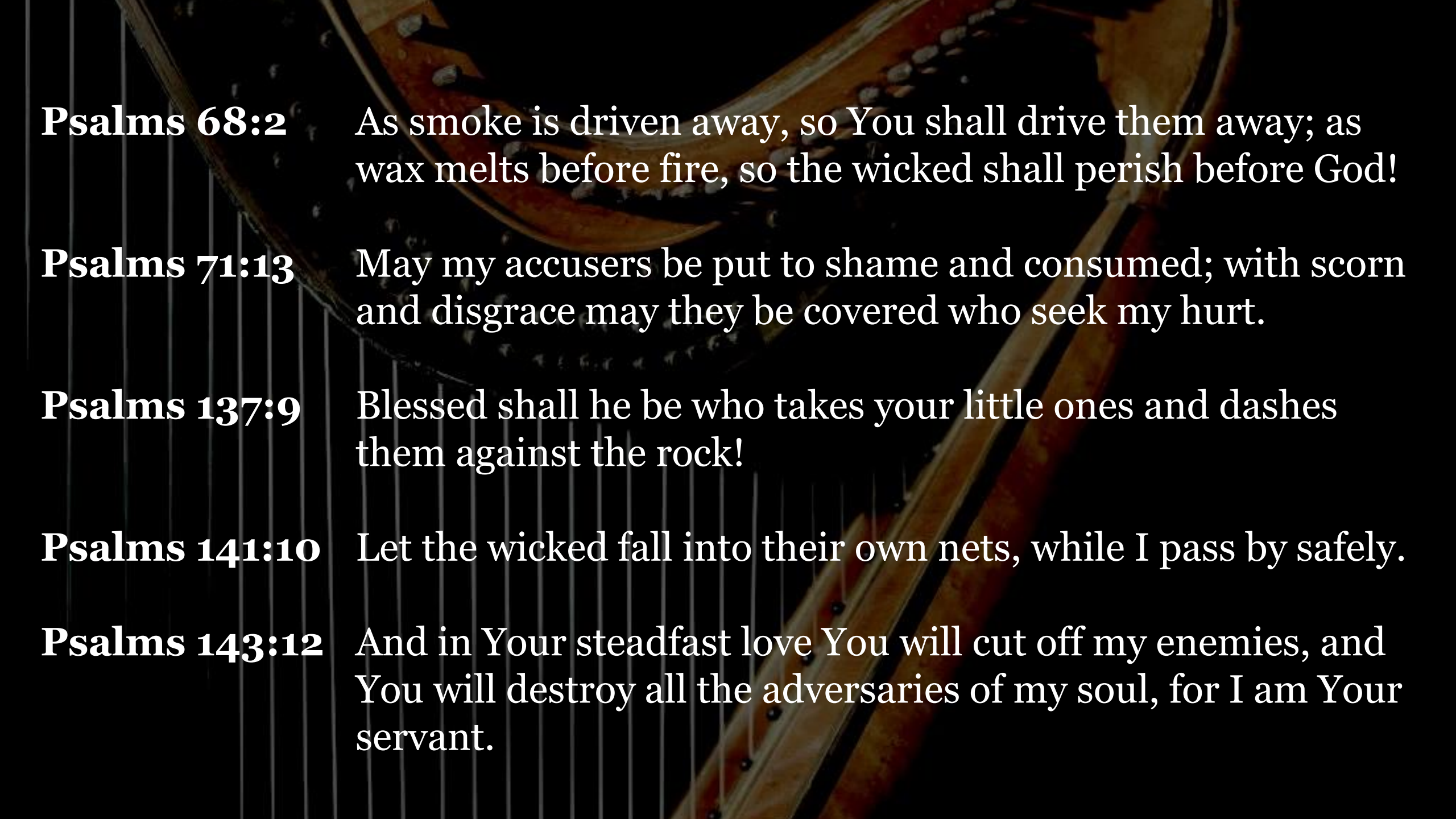

Psalms 68:2 As smoke is driven away, so You shall drive them away; as wax melts before fire, so the wicked shall perish before God!

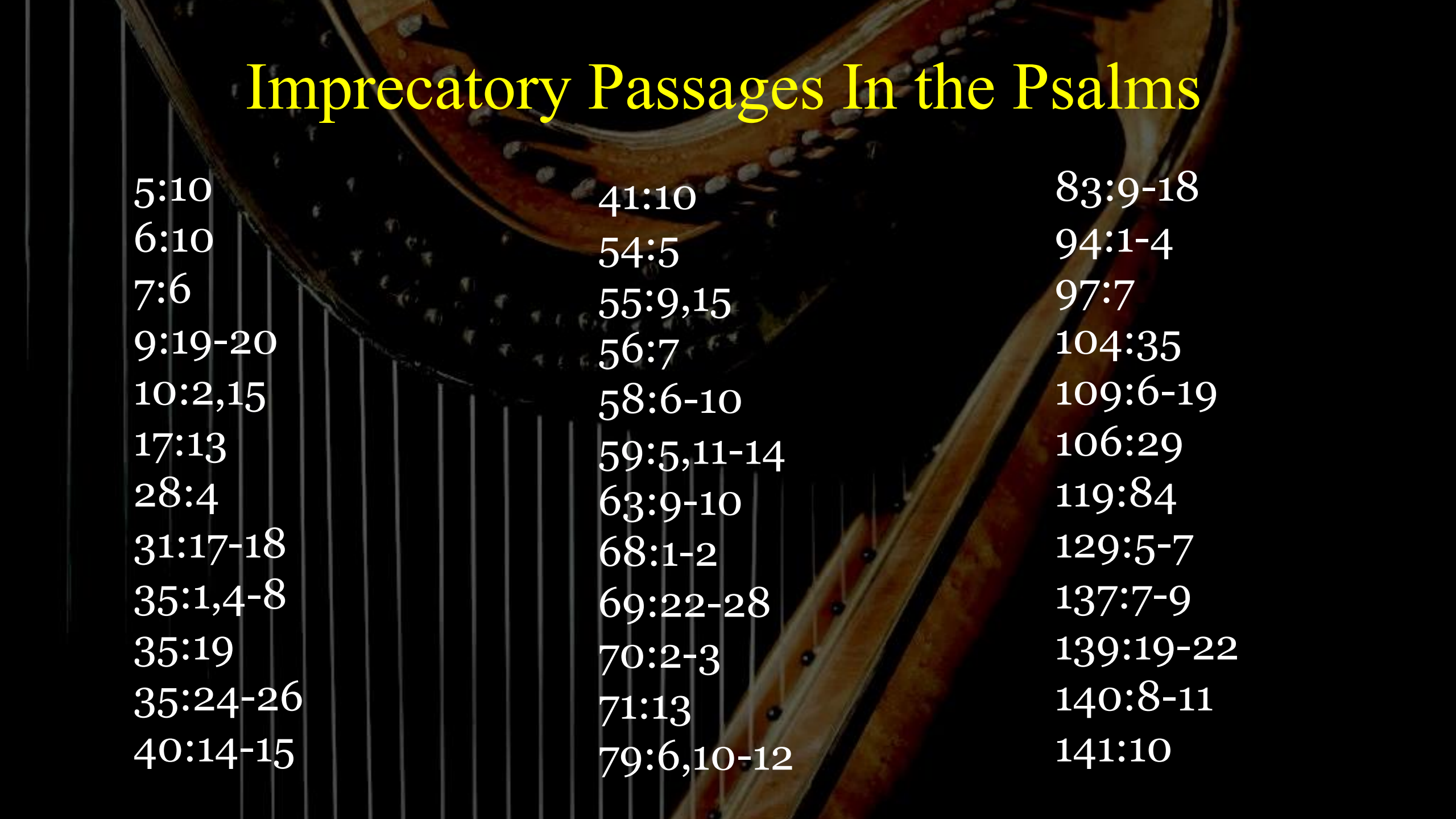
Psalms 71:13 May my accusers be put to shame and consumed; with scorn and disgrace may they be covered who seek my hurt.

Psalms 143:12 And in Your steadfast love You will cut off my enemies, and You will destroy all the adversaries of my soul, for I am Your servant.
